Important Notes:

- As per the family's wishes, preference will be given to applicants employed in and/or pursuing continuing education in neurology, neurosurgery, stroke rehabilitation and/or brain injury care.
- If your application is successful, you will be required to submit verification of eligible costs (e.g., receipt for tuition and/or exam fees) and proof of successful attendance (conference/workshop) or proof of successful completion of the course/program/certification exam to claim your bursary. Any additional documentation requirements will be outlined in the notification email you receive from the Trust.
- If you are successful in achieving full funding from other sources, you will be asked to
 accept the other funding. If you receive notification that you have received full funding after
 you have received your bursary from the Trust, you are required to notify the Trust and
 return the Trust funds.
- Deadline for receipt of applications:
 - o April 15th for conferences between January and June;
 - o October 15th for conferences between July and December.
 - Unless otherwise stated on the Trust website, applications for certification outside of the specified timeframe will not be accepted (e.g., applications for a conference between January and June will not be accepted in the fall competition).
