

#### **Research Awards Committee Terms of Reference**

#### <u>Objective</u>

- 1. To review applications for research awards and select successful applicants based on the scientific merit, relevance, potential contribution to nursing, clarity and feasibility.
- 2. To notify the Awards Committee of successful applicants and amount of the research awards to be awarded (within parameters established by the Awards Committee).
- To review and recommend revisions to the award review process and criteria for awards as necessary. Revisions shall be submitted to the Board of Directors for approval.

#### **Status**

A sub-committee of the Trust Awards Committee.

### <u>Membership</u>

The Research Award Review Committee shall consist of a minimum of five current CRNNL members with experience in research appointed by the Trust Board of Directors. No more than one-third of the Committee shall be non-practicing members of CRNNL. Committee members shall have a minimum preparation of a graduate degree. It is preferable that the reviewers have a current record of research.

The Committee has the option to add an ad-hoc member when additional expertise is needed.

#### **Chairperson**

The members among themselves shall choose the Chairperson.

#### Terms of Office

Committee members will serve a 3-year term of office. Members are eligible to serve three consecutive terms. Where possible, membership will be staggered to promote consistency.

Ad-hoc members will serve as a committee member for only the year their expertise is required.

#### <u>Secretary</u>

The Trust Coordinator shall serve as secretary to the Committee.

#### **Meetings**

The Committee shall meet as necessary at the call of the Chairperson.

# **Budget**

The Awards Committee shall establish the annual budget for the Research Award Review Committee. Reasonable expenses of Committee members will be paid in accordance with the Newfoundland & Labrador Registered Nurses' Education & Research Trust.

## **Eligibility for Funding**

Members of the Committee are eligible to apply for Trust Research Awards. A committee member who applies must declare a conflict and cannot participate in the review.
